EVENT TERMS & CONDITIONS

- The event is subject to license.
- Entry to the event will only be permitted by ticket and the event management reserve the right to refuse entry.
- The event management reserve the right to evict anyone from the event who is found to have contravened any of these Terms & Conditions.
- It is required that anyone visiting the event must wear the event wristband provided at all times and, if asked, to show proof of age through identification. Anyone under the age of 18 must be accompanied by an adult.
- Acceptable identification: Driving Licence/Passport/PASS (Proof of Age Standards Scheme). The event will be implementing the Challenge 25 Scheme.
- Tickets are non-refundable unless the event is cancelled. The event will continue should the weather conditions change and mean that the ground could become wet and muddy and all visitors are required to wear sensible footwear. This will also mean that the event management reserves the right NOT to cancel the event and reasonable adjustments be made if necessary.
- No alcohol or glass or food to be brought into the venue.
- No contraband or illegal substances are permitted to be brought into the venue nor any item that might be used as a weapon.

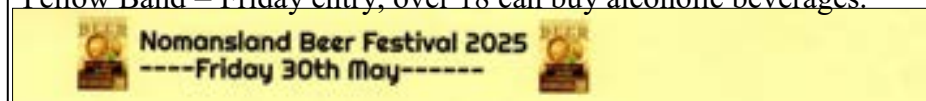

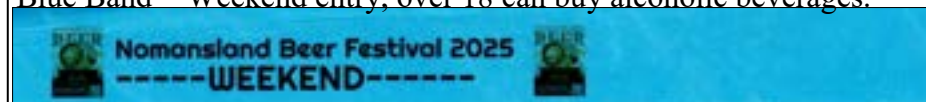
WRIST-BANDS
